Pacific Association Hall of Fame Nomination Criteria

(updated 1 September, 2015)

A Pacific Association Hall of Fame Committee has been set-up to assist Association Awards Chairman Leroy Milam with nominations and selections for Association awards. The current members of the Hall are listed on the association website. The HoF committee is looking for nominations for future inductees. This includes Officials, Open and Master Athletes, Coaches, Trainers, Meet Director, Administrator and supporters. Below is a quick rundown on who should be considered for nomination:

All nominees must have been:

- 1) a Member of Pacific Association for at least 10 years since 1980.
- 2) involved in one or more of our athletic disciplines.

As an **Athlete** should have been an American or World record holder, a National Champion, an Olympian, a World or an Area Champion, and ranked at some time by IAAF, WMA or USATF.

As an **Official** should have been at least National Level (usually Master), having worked association, national and possibly international meets with leadership and clinical and mentoring skills.

As a **Coach or Trainer** should have helped build youth or post collegiate athletes in the association and helped train/mentor other coaches.

As a **Meet Director** should have served for many years in meet management roles at major meets at any level in the association.

As an **Administrator** should been a long time contributor to the running of the Association wither as a member of the Board of Athletics or an Association or club committee.

At least for the foreseeable future until we catch up, we would plan to induce at least one member from each of these groups each year. Some individuals may serve to represent more than one group.

If you have questions you can ask any of the committee members who are Leroy Milam, John Mansoor, Dave Shrock and George Kleeman. If you would like to volunteer to help on the committee, let one of us know. We would welcome the help.

The 2015 Induction Ceremony will take place on Tuesday evening, November 17, before the Board of Athletics Meeting at Heather Farms in Walnut Creek. Further information and this year's inductees will be listed on the Pacific Associations Webpage as well as its Facebook page in October.

If you have a candidate in one of these categories please forward them with a brief summary of why they belong as a Pacific Association Hall of Fame candidate and included their contact information such as phone number, address and email to George Kleeman at george kleeman@comcast.net. This can be done at any time of the year. Inductions will normally be in the fall of the year.
