Last Fall, we held the NorCal Striders Youth XC Meet in Redding, part of the USATF Pacific Assoc. Grand Prix Youth Series and the first of its kind in the North State. We had kids from all over the Bay Area come up to race and we're scheduled to have the event again this Fall on Oct.13th. Athletic Background – I was a college All-American at Black Hill State Univ. in the 10,000 meter run. I qualified for the 1984 & 1988 U.S. Olympic Marathon Trials, was 3rd place at the 1987 USA National Marathon Championships in Houston and an alternate for the Pan American Games that same year for the U.S. in the men's marathon. My commitment to our USATF Pacific Association youth's success is huge. We've added almost 20 new members to our association in the Redding area & more will be joining in the next few weeks.
